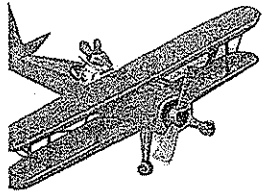



The Beech Tree Elementary School community is working closely with FCPS and the Fairfax County Health department as we face the challenges of an active flu season.

Influenza-related activities continue to be on the upswing with increased reports of influenza-like illness. Virginia has reached the classification of "widespread" for flu-like illnesses with 99 percent of all subtype influenza A viruses being reported to CDC as influenza A (H1N1) viruses. FCPS continues to work with Fairfax County Health Department (FCHD) on preventing the transmission of flu.

We continue to urge those with flu-like illness to stay home for at least 24 hours after they no longer have a fever, or signs of a fever, without the use of fever-reducing medicines. The symptoms of H1N1 flu are similar to the symptoms of seasonal flu and include fever, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headaches, chills, and fatigue.
