Dear Parent or Guardian:

Each year, the presence of federal activity in Virginia affects the Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) operating budget. We are requesting your assistance in identifying federally -connected students for our Impact Aid federal grant program.

Our budget is largely financed through local property taxes; however, federal properties such as military bases, subsidized housing, and government agencies are exempt from some local and state taxes. As a result, FCPS does not receive all of the operating revenues that would normally be generated through the collection of these taxes.

The Impact Aid Program provides technical assistance and funds to local educational agencies that are financially impacted by federal activities. FCPS receives approximately \$3,500,000 from this grant program each year. The funds become a part of the school system's general operating budget that supports activities for all students and are critical to sustaining the high quality of education that FCPS provides for your children.

FCPS uses the Student-Parent Survey to support our request for Impact Aid funds. For each school-aged student in your household, please complete sections 2 through 6 of the survey. Sign, date, and return the completed survey to your child's school before November 6, 2009. Any information that you provide will be treated confidentially.
