Certifications

Students must meet the state's mandatory competency requirement. Upon graduation, they will be prepared to take the Virginia State Board of Cosmetology licensing exam to earn a license as a Licensed Cosmetologist

Course Description

The Cosmetology two-year program provides an overview to the Cosmetology field as well as in-depth training in personal grooming and fashion. Students who study cosmetology earn two credits each year and learn how to care for hair, skin and nails. Topics include basic hygiene, sanitation, styling, facials, makeup, manicuring and pedicuring. The course also includes topics on the anatomy of the head, face, neck and arms as well as hygiene techniques used in a beauty salon. In a laboratory setting, students learn skills in hair styling and cutting, permanent waving, hair coloring, scalp and facial treatment, and manicuring. Students operate a full service salon with the emphasis on safety sanitation, professional ethics and quality work.
