**Scholarships for the Class of 2008**

The following scholarships are available to graduates of Chantilly H.S. only, so any seniors that qualify are STRONGLY encouraged to apply. All applications are available in the Career Center.

**Paula Chudoba Scholarship (Deadline extended to Friday, May 16)**

One award of \$2,000 is available to a senior that has an interest in any field of special education. All applicants must have been a student at Chantilly for at least two years.

**Chantilly PTSA "Career and Technical Education" Award (Due Monday, May 19)**

An award (minimum \$250) is available to a student who has demonstrated excellence in the Career and Technical Education studies program at Chantilly HS and Chantilly Academy. This scholarship shall be used towards funding post-secondary education including four-year, two-year and vocational programs. Students must submit a one-page essay discussing "how your Career and Technical Education studies fit into your goals".

### **Chantilly PTSA "Challenge to Succeed" Award (Due Monday, May 19)**

An award (minimum \$250) is available to a student who has a current Individualized Education Program (IEP) in place and who has overcome obstacles on the road to either academic or social success. The scholarship shall be used to fund post-secondary education, including four-year, two-year or vocational programs to include the Davis Center. The application must include an answer to the question "What have you accomplished socially or academically that you are most proud of?" (This can be communicated in a variety of ways, written or dictated to someone, a piece of art, a photo, a recording are some suggestions.)

### **Chantilly PTSA "Reach and Achieve" Award (Due Monday, May 19)**

An award (minimum \$250) is available to a student who will be the first in the immediate family to attend college. This scholarship shall be used towards funding post-secondary education at a four-year college or university. Students must submit a one-page essay discussing the significance of being the first member of their family to attend college.

### **Yuthud Oberdick Scholarship (Due Monday, May 19)**

One award of \$1,000 is available to a senior that has been enrolled in regular education social studies classes only throughout high school. All applicants must have been a student at Chantilly for at least two years and shown a love of social studies through the taking of elective courses in the discipline.
