

## Chantilly High School Supply Lists for 2007-2008 School Year

Chantilly High School does not maintain one uniform list of supplies needed. Teachers are invited to post their supply lists here by the end of June for the following school year. Please check back at the end of June 2007 or during the summer to see if your teacher has posted a supply list.

### History Department

Supplies for World History I and II with Morgan/Murphy:

- 2-4 glue sticks (get more at the start of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter)
- A 100 page spiral notebook (not 70 pages)
- A pack of colored pencils or crayons
- A box of markers
- Blunt edged scissors
- Tape (or a little stapler)
- 1" binder with 5-7 tabs
- You must have an agenda-plan to use it every day.
- Enjoy your summer!

### Math Department

Calculator Information:

- Math students in Algebra 1 will be issued TI-83, TI-83 Plus or TI-84 Plus graphing calculators at the beginning of the 2007-2008 school year.
- Algebra 2 students will be issued calculators if they need one. If your student is enrolled in Algebra 2 for next year and is planning to take additional math courses you may chose to purchase a calculator for him/her.
- Students in any courses above Algebra 2 are expected to provide their own calculators.
- Teachers will demonstrate problems in class using the TI-83, TI 83 Plus or TI-84 Plus graphing calculator.

Calculators generally go on sale in August in anticipation of the new school year but often sell out quickly.

Students who are planning on taking Calculus BC next year will be issued TI-89 calculators. There is no requirement to purchase this calculator. Students in Calculus BC may use a calculator from the TI-83/TI-84 series or the TI-89 (or both).

Supplies Needed:

- A lab notebook IS required. Softbound or spiral, these make a copy as you write. GMU bookstore, ~\$20, cheaper on Amazon. If you just *have* to type everything, you will need to have a three ring binder instead, to keep your completed labs, and print two copies.
- If cost of supplies is a problem, please see me outside of class or through your counselor so we can help you work something out.
- Use a binder or notebook for notes.
- Keep a folder for handouts.
- Graphing/Scientific Calculator
