## Entry Requirements

Applicants must submit:

- 💡 Completed application Form
- 💡 Two letters of recommendation/reference. (Minimum of one educational or professional reference and one personal reference from educators and/or employers who are familiar with your background)
- 💡 Academic transcripts. Official transcripts do not need to be sent directly from school; however, they must bear the original Registrar Seal. Photocopies will not be accepted.
- 💡 200-300 word essay on educational and career goals and reasons to be awarded scholarship.

## Eligibility

Monetary scholarship awarded for the 2009/2010 school year.

- 💡 Enrolled in a Washington D.C. Metro Area school
- 💡 Pursuing education in the field of electricity
- 💡 Have not previously received DFSF Scholarship
- 💡 Applicant must be a U.S. citizen
- 💡 Applicant must be 18 or older; or possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent.

## Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated based on the quality of their academic records, career objectives, letters of recommendation and extracurricular activities.

## Time Schedule

Complete applications must be postmarked by July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009. The scholarship recipients will be notified by August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

## Support Provided

The scholarship will provide a one-time grant of \$2,000 to the most outstanding applicant(s) meeting the eligibility requirements. The number of recipients may vary from year to year.
