

## Eligibility

Only students enrolled in a Virginia public school who have passed a high school level tested course (or courses) but need to achieve a passing score on the associated Virginia SOL test (or tests) may register to take an EOC SOL test without participating in a remediation session or summer school course. Current grade 9 through 11 students enrolled in a Virginia public school, have the opportunity to take the test(s) in the fall of 2007 and spring of 2008 at their base school.

Non-Fairfax County, Virginia, public school students should read the **Registration Requirements** on page 46 regarding registration procedures and requirements.

## Registration and Tuition

Students enrolled in a Virginia public school who have earned the appropriate standard credit may register to take no more than three Virginia SOL tests during the summer. It is possible to take the Writing SOL test in July and two additional SOL tests (one per day) on August 7 and 8. **Students must register by the required deadlines in order to take tests.** Tests are not administered to students who do not register on time.

**All students, including limited English proficient (LEP) and special education, must preregister in order to receive appropriate accommodation.**

**Students may only take the test identified on their completed registration form. No additional tests or switching of tests is permitted.**

FCPS students should select the summer school test site that serves their base school; see page 27.

Complete registration **Form E** on page 55, and attach a copy of the report card that shows the student passed the course.

The registration form must be signed by the student's counselor. Documentation, registration forms, and payment may be **mailed to** Summer School Registration, Adult and Community Education (ACE), 6815 Edsall Road, Springfield, VA 22151 (not a walk-in site) or **faxed to** 703-658-1275. **Walk-in** registration will be conducted only at the Bryant, Central Fairfax, and Centreville ACE registration centers. There is no cost to retake an end-of-course SOL test.
