Refund Information

To submit a refund or withdrawal request:

1. Prepare a written request for a refund or complete the online form at <http://www.fcps.edu/DIS/OCTE/events/TechCamp.htm>.
2. Include in the request: student's name, home address for the parent or guardian, phone number, amount paid, reason for request, and signature. The written request must be received by June 29, 2009.

4. A \$15 processing fee is assessed on all refund requests.
5. Please allow several weeks for processing.

Eligibility

Students currently enrolled in grades 5-7 during the 2008-09 year are eligible for the Tech Adventure Camp experience.

Location and Times

The Tech Adventure Camp will be held at the Chantilly High School Academy and Lee High School, July 6-17, 2009, from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Tuition

Tuition is \$400. All materials and supplies are included.

Lunch

Students are encouraged to bring a bag lunch for the midday break. Limited lunch selections will be available each day.

Transportation

Students may arrange their own transportation to Chantilly or Lee High School or use (FCPS) bus transportation at no additional cost. Refer to the following chart for middle school pyramid assignments to either Chantilly or Lee High School. Students may attend a site out of their local school assignment; however, bus transportation will not be provided. For students using bus transportation, efforts are made to arrange pickup and drop-off at the elementary, middle, or high school closest to their homes; the final determination will be made after all students are registered.

Pickup sites and bus schedules will be mailed to students in early July.
