Dear Parent/Guardian:


We need your help. Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) is facing a very lean budget this year with the School Board passing the most stringent school operating budget in more than a decade. Our operating budget has been impacted by Fairfax County's depressed real estate market and the declining tax base that traditionally supports our school system. You can help by completing the Student-Parent Survey so that FCPS can obtain its fair share of federal grant funds through the Impact Aid program. FCPS receives approximately \$3,000,000 annually from this program.

The mission of the Impact Aid Program is to provide technical assistance and funds to local educational agencies that are financially burdened by federal activities. Federal properties such as military bases, subsidized housing, and government agencies are exempt from some local and state taxes. FCPS loses a portion of its operating revenues that would normally be generated through the collection of these taxes.

FCPS uses the Student-Parent Survey (on the reverse side of this letter) to support our request for Impact Aid funds. For each school-aged child in your household, please complete sections 2 through 6 of the survey. Be sure to sign, date, and return the completed survey to your child's school before November 14, 2008. The survey should be completed even if you don't think it applies to your child. Any information that you provide will be treated confidentially.
