Televising Curricular and Extracurricular Activities or Events

This policy supercedes Policy 6860.

I. PURPOSE

To establish policy with regard to televising curricular and extracurricular activities or events.

II. CONDITIONS

Televising certain school activities or events of public interest for rebroadcast via cable or public television is authorized when the rebroadcast will contribute to the welfare of the participants, the school, and the community. Reuse by broadcasters or producers of videotapes or other graphic records made of school activities and events without the express prior written consent of Fairfax County Public Schools is prohibited. To secure consent, broadcasters or producers must agree to be bound by Fairfax County Public Schools policies and regulations, including the content of the recording rebroadcast, approval of commercials and commentators, and use of students or staff members.

III. AUTHORIZATION

The Division Superintendent or his or her designee is authorized to enter into agreements regarding the televising of school activities and events.
