Al and Winnie Hodgson Student Award Program

This regulation supersedes Regulation 3832.4

I. PURPOSE

To establish procedures for awarding U.S. Savings Bonds annually to high school students who demonstrate excellence in specified categories. This award will continue until the trust funds are depleted.

II. SUMMARY OF CHANGES SINCE LAST PUBLICATION

This regulation has been rewritten in its entirety.

III. BACKGROUND

The money for the awards is provided by a trust fund established through a contribution given by Mr. and Mrs. Alfred Hodgson. Mr. Hodgson served as Dranesville District School Board member from 1972 to 1976. He requested that the awards be known as the "Al and Winnie Hodgson Awards."

IV. AWARD CATEGORIES

One student in each of the following categories shall receive one U.S. Savings Bond (\$200 face value) annually.

1. Fine arts
2. Mentorship
3. English composition
4. Foreign language
5. Mathematics
6. Science (physics, chemistry, biology)
7. Social studies

8. Career and technical education

V. NOMINATION PROCEDURES

Students nominated for the Virginia Governor's School shall constitute the eligibility pool to be considered for the Al and Winnie Hodgson Student Awards program.

VI. SELECTION PROCEDURES

Selection of each student to receive an award shall be based on the student receiving the highest cumulative score on the Governor's School application for each of the eight designated categories.
