

ABOUT FAIRFAX HIGH SCHOOL'S DRAMA MINI-CAMP MONDAY APRIL 7, 2008

The Staff: Ms. Wendy Knight, Theatre Director, is the director. The counselors are the F/X Players, our dedicated and talented high school theatre students. They are supported by the Fairfax High School Theatre Boosters, some of whom will be on hand all day to provide extra adult supervision. The staff to camper ratio will be at least 5:1.

The Campers: are divided into groups according to current grade levels: 1st-2nd, 3rd-4th, 5th-6th, and 7th-8th.

Registration/Sign In/Out: You will be contacted by phone or email when your application has been received. Registration begins at 8:45 a.m. at tables just inside the main entrance to Fairfax High School. Walk-in registration is possible on a space available basis. Walk-in campers are advised to arrive at 8:30. Parents will be asked to complete an emergency care form (available at www.fcps.edu; copies will be available at the registration table as well). Campers will pick up their name tags at the tables, and a parent will be required to enter the school to sign the child in and out. If an older child will be walking home from camp, parents must provide written permission for them to sign themselves out.

The Schedule: Camp is from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Each age group will follow its own schedule of acting/improv and technical activities. Technical activities may include props/runners (scene changing) crew, set design, sound/lighting (sorry, campers are not allowed in the sound booth as this is restricted to those with a tech license), make up, and costumes.

Lunch: Campers will bring their own lunch and drink and will eat with the staff in the cafeteria. You may pre-order pizza and a drink. We will provide a snack and drink in the early afternoon.
