Effective Dates for Graduation Requirements

Standard and Verified Units of Credit Requirements

Students must earn standard and verified credits for most diploma types. A standard credit is awarded when a student passes a course. A verified credit is awarded when a student passes a course and passes the related SOL test. Charts below show the number of credits required for the standard, advanced studies, and modified diplomas.

Graduation Requirements

Standard Diploma: 22 Units of Credit for those students entering 9th grade for the first time in 2000-2001, 2001-2002, and 2002-2003 respectively (**Graduation Classes of 2004, 2005, 2006**)
