

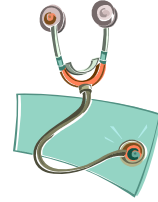

- HS seniors who complete the first portion of the practical nursing program may continue to the post-graduate level offered in the fall following HS graduation.
- HS students successfully completing the NOCTI Health Care Foundations exam can earn verified credit.
- Upon successful completion of the 9-month post-graduate level, students are eligible to take the state Board of Nursing licensure exam (NCLEX-PN) for practical nursing. Upon passing the NCLEX exam, graduates are licensed as practical nurses (LPN's)



Upon earning the LPN license, graduates can be employed as LPN's only 1 year after HS graduation!

The FCPS practical nursing program offers small class size and reasonable tuition.

Tuition and fees*:

High School level fees are ~ \$150. for uniforms and supplies

Post-graduate level tuition is ~ \$2,400

Benefits:

- Ability to work as LPN's while pursuing further education—earn while they learn.

How much do LPNs make? According to a recent survey, the average wage is \$17.24 an hour, which equals \$35,800 a year.

- Employers frequently offer tuition reimbursement to earn RN or BSN.

Local College Opportunities:

Many local colleges offer fast-track programs for LPN to RN or LPN to BSN.



*FCPS graduates who choose to enter the program after high school graduation must take a pre-entrance exam.
