Parking Lots at our building are scheduled to be swept on the week of April 7, 2008.

Sweeping will take place between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., Monday through Friday, in order to eliminate impact on school functions and accommodate the necessary equipment.

This is a two day process consisting of hand sweeping and power blowing in the corners and behind curb bumpers on the first day, and power sweeping and vacuum pick up using a commercial vacuum truck on the second day.

This activity is performed as one of several best management practices associated with the federally mandated Municipal Separate Storm System (MS4) program which is part of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System. The objective of this program is to locally reduce storm water pollutant in the runoff. In Virginia this program is regulated by the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR). Fairfax County Public Schools is required to submit an annual report of compliance to DCR.
