It is imperative that our students arrive to school on time as part of his or her daily school routine. The importance of our students being in class for those precious morning activities, planned by our teachers to help our students prepare for their learning day, cannot be overstated. Our arrival procedures are listed below in hopes that this information helps you, and your student prepare for an on-time school arrival.

Doors open for students at 8:10 – (there is no adult supervision prior to 8:10)

- Grades K – 2 and Forest, Schmidt, and Hoke 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classrooms go to the cafeteria
- Students eating breakfast go to the cafeteria
- Breakfast is served at 8:10
- Grades 4 – 6 and two 3<sup>rd</sup> grade homerooms (Lanning and Cagno) go to the Gym

Students are dismissed from the gym and cafeteria at 8:30

All teachers are in the classroom doorways to welcome students.

The side Kiss and Ride door is locked at 8:40. At that time, students need to enter school through Door #1 and go to the office to receive a tardy pass.
