

KINDERGARTEN COURSE DESCRIPTIONS A.M. and P.M.

Combination 1

AM Class: ** Leaping Letters

K

By Invitation Only

This class will reinforce students' phonemic awareness and letter recognition skills through various hands-on activities. Students will also gain exposure to early reading concepts through books, songs, and games. Leaping Letters will provide students with activities that will enhance their excitement and readiness for reading. (Language Arts)

PM Class: ** Leaping Numbers

This class will reinforce students' math skills through various hands-on activities. (Math)

Combination 2

AM Class: Rising Stars

K

Ready! Set! Rise to first grade! *Rising Stars* will focus on kindergarten reading, writing and math skills. (Language Arts, Math)

PM Class: Let's Explore Dinosaurs

K

Want to learn about dinosaurs? In this class, we'll have fun learning about dinosaurs -- what they looked like, what they ate, and how they lived and died. We will make dinosaur pillows and clay models. We will make a dinosaur book and write in our dinosaur journals. (Language Arts, Science)

Combination 3

AM Class: The Ant, The Bug and The Bee

K

Students will engage in hands-on activities while learning about bugs and insects in the world around us. We will make art projects, graphs, read stories and learn all out about our creepy, crawly friends. (Language Arts, Math, Science)

PM Class: Rising Stars

Combination 4

AM Class: Over in the Meadow

PM Class: Go Buggy!

Learn about the world of bugs through the literature of Eric Carle. We will read books about bugs and do lots of fun art projects! (Language Arts, Science, Math, Art)

Combination 5

AM Class: Ocean Adventures

K

In this course, children will learn about oceans and the animals that live in them all over the world. This literature-based course will ask children to demonstrate their understanding of the ocean and its animals through various writing and art activities. Children will incorporate math skills as they graph favorite ocean animals and compare and contrast dimensions of different animals found in the ocean. Each day will be filled with fun and excitement as children embark on this "Ocean Adventure". (Language Arts, Math, Science)
