Dear Parent or Guardian:

The presence of federally-owned, and therefore tax-exempt, properties in Virginia impacts the Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) operating budget. We are requesting your assistance in identifying federally-connected students for our federal Impact Aid grant program.

FCPS' budget is largely financed through local property taxes; however, military bases, low-rent housing properties, and other federal properties are exempt from some local and state property taxes. As a result, our school district does not receive all of the operating revenues that would normally be generated through the collection of these taxes.

The federal Impact Aid grant program provides funds and technical support to local educational agencies that are financially impacted by federal activities. Each year, FCPS receives roughly \$3,500,000 in unrestricted funds from this program. The funds become a part of the school system's general operating budget and are critical to supporting the high quality of education that FCPS provides for your children.

The Student-Parent Survey is used to support our request for Impact Aid funds. For each school-aged student in your household, please complete sections 2 through 6 of the survey. Sign, date, and return the completed survey (via fax, mail, or backpack) to your child's school by November 7, 2011. The survey is available on the reverse side of this memo.
