

Fort Belvoir Elementary's NEW Door Entry System

Attention Fort Belvoir Families:

As part of a continuing system-wide initiative to maintain and enhance safety and security in Fairfax County Public Schools, all elementary and middle schools have had new door security technologies installed. This security system allows for a more secure facility during regular school hours through limiting access to the main entrance, while allowing students and staff access at needed entrances.

We are currently awaiting for the system to be transferred from the contractor to the county before we can begin using the system. We anticipate going forward in January or February. More information will be sent home when this happens.

Overview for visitors:

When visitors arrive at the front lobby door, they will need to stand on the footprints, press the button on the wall panel located on the building wall closest to the door. Identification will be requested by the front office staff through the video/audio receivers. Once identification has been made, a buzzer will sound and the door will be unlocked for the visitor to enter the building and report to the Greeter desk for check-in.

This system provides a greater security for the entire school community: staff, students and parents. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.
