## ACADEMICS

The primary purpose of the **ACCESS** program is to provide targeted academic support for our students. Glasgow Instructional staff may be available **Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday** to provide academic support opportunities. This approach will ensure that each student will receive homework assistance, tutoring, quiz & test make-ups, and additional resources directly from one of their grade level teachers.

All students must make an academic commitment in order to attend the ACCESS program. Each member of the instructional staff has **ACCESS Cards** in their possession. It is the responsibility of each student to request a single card from one of their core or elective teachers or to accept one that is offered to gain ACCESS to the After School Program.

Students who have received an **Academic Card** from a teacher should report directly to that teacher following dismissal. Once the student's academic commitment has been completed, students may be released to sign-up and to participate in activities.

ACCESS Cards are not required for participation on Tuesday or Friday afternoons. However, transportation arrangements must be clearly marked on the After School Registration form for the 09'-10' school year.

## ACTIVITIES



In addition to academic support, ACCESS provides a variety of fun, engaging, and enriching opportunities for students to invest their extra-curricular time and interest.

We have set a minimal expectation for academics for each day of the week as outlined in the **Access Daily Schedule**. It is the expectation of all students that they fulfill their academic responsibilities for the afternoon prior to activity participation. Following activity dismissal, students who have not fulfilled this commitment will be asked to continue working until they have completed all required assignments and tasks.




Students who have received an **Activity Card** from a teacher should report directly to the cafeteria to register for one of the available activities for the afternoon. On typical afternoons there are 12-15 activities available to choose from. Once registered, students should make their way to the instructional staff member who provided the ACCESS card for academic support.

Activities will be available Monday-Friday until 5:45pm. Students who have made arrangements for Parent Pick-Up or that live in the walking boundaries of the school are also welcome to stay on Tuesday and Friday afternoons, as well as participate in recreation and sport, and prevention based activities. Academic support is provided in a reduced capacity on Tuesday afternoons, however Fridays do not consist of an academic component.
