Spreadsheet Notes:

This report tells you about your achievement on major (summative) assessments during the current marking period.

We measure achievement levels in the Humanities using four weighted criteria that use scales ranging from 0-8 and 0-10. At the end of the quarter, teachers use this information to determine students' overall level of achievement in the humanities and to award an FCPS letter grade. For Humanities criteria A, B, and C, marks in the range of 9-10 are characteristic of "A" quality work; for criterion D, marks in the range of 7-8 are characteristic of "A" quality work. Marks below 4 indicate that students may not be demonstrating proficiency in the Humanities.

PLEASE NOTE: MYP marks are not based on points or percentages. For example, achievement level 8 on a scale that has a maximum of 10 does not indicate that a student knows 80% of the material, nor that the student is 20% less accomplished than the smartest student in the course, nor that the student's work is "average."
