Parent Tips for Academic Success



1. Be supportive of your child's education, remember this is their job!
2. Make sure your child gets a good night sleep and eats a good breakfast everyday.
3. Take time to read with your child. Students should read at least 30 minutes each night.
4. Let a teacher/counselor/principal know if you have a particular concern regarding academics or otherwise. (Translators are available in all languages.)
5. Read the Student/Parent/Guardian Handbook together and go over the rules and policies of the school.
6. Encourage your child to talk about any concerns they have about starting the school year.
7. Attempt to view your child's issues from the perspective of all involved.
8. Make sure your child leaves home with all of their school materials. This should include their binder, textbooks, agenda, and *homework*.
9. Register for FCPS 24/7 Learning and the Keep in Touch systems. They will provide you with information about your child's school and individual classes.
10. Review your child's academic progress with them and their teacher throughout the school year.
11. Encourage your child to participate in the after school program. Late buses run on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday.
12. Review your child's agenda book each night. Look for their daily homework and any upcoming projects.
