

# **Fifth Grade School Supply List 2008-2009**

Please label all items with the student's name.

- 4 – spiral notebooks, 70 pages per notebook
- 2 - packages of loose leaf paper – wide ruled
- 1 - 12 inch school ruler that shows both inches and centimeters – please check carefully
- 1 - pair of scissors
- 1 - clipboard – standard size
- 1 - large gluestick
- 1 - box of washable markers
- 1 – package black dry erase markers, 4-6 markers per package
- 1 - package of #2 pencils
- 1 - package of colored pencils
- 1 - package (4-6 black) dry erase markers
- 1 - inexpensive, four function calculator (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division)
- 1 - simple, clear protractor
- 5 - pocket folders – with brads – one for music
- 2 - marble composition notebooks
- 2 - regular boxes of tissues
- 1 - recorder – Yamaha model is preferred

**Assignment notebooks are provided by the PTA.**

**No Trapper Keepers or large binders, please.**

**Avoid large containers which clutter the students' desks.**

**No Pencil boxes, please – zippered pencil cases only**
