

# Fifth Grade 2009-2010

**Please label all items with the student's name.**

- 2 -Packages of loose leaf paper - wide ruled
- 3 -Spiral notebooks 70 pages (one each for science, math & social studies)
- 1 -12 inch school ruler that shows both inches **and** centimeters (Please check carefully.)
- 1 -Pair of scissors
- 1 -Clipboard - standard size
- 1 -Large gluestick
- 1 -Box of washable colored markers
- 2 packages (4-6 black) dry erase markers
- 2 -Packages of #2 pencils
- 1 -Package of presharpended colored pencils
- 1 -Inexpensive, four function calculator (Addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division)
- 1 -Simple, **clear** protractor (do not buy opaque protractor or protractor with sweep arm)
- 5 -Pocket folders - with brads one each yellow, blue, green, blue and one for music.
- 2 -Marble composition notebooks (one for reading, one for writing)
- 2 -Regular boxes of tissues
- 1 -Recorder - Yamaha model is preferred
- 1 - 16 oz Hand Sanitizer

**No Trapper Keepers or large binders please.**

**Avoid large containers which clutter the students' desks.**
