### Kiss-N-Ride Procedures

These procedures apply to both

- Walk on sidewalks and cross only at intersections.
- Patrols will be stationed at all hazardous intersections for safety.
- Do not walk through neighborhood yards.
- Parents will want to talk to children regarding never accepting rides from strangers and following all safety rules.

## Hierarchy of Consequences



- Non-Verbal Cues

- Time-out in another Classroom/Parent Contact
- After School Detention
- Behavior Support Team Referral
- Office Referral\*
- CT Button\*



\*Parents may be notified at any level depending on the severity of the situation or problem.

\*Some inappropriate student behavior may warrant immediate use of more severe consequences.
