- Beginning this fall, all IEPs will be developed using the standards-based IEP process and will contain a standards-based goal in math, if the student has a math goal.
- IEP teams will create annual IEP goals that align to grade level curriculum.
- Standards-based IEPs will incorporate guided questions to determine the student's present level of performance and areas of need.
- FCPS will begin using standards-based IEP goals for reading and writing during the 2012-2013 school year.
