Be a book critic! Write a one to two page book review by including the following information.

A. General Book Information

1. Title
2. Author
3. Genre (i.e. realistic fiction, science fiction, biography, etc...)
4. Number of pages



B. Summarize the book

1. One paragraph (50 – 100 words)
2. Include brief statements about the setting, main character(s), and plot.

C. Critique the book

1. Setting (one paragraph)
 - a. Is the setting described in detail?
 - b. Can you imagine yourself there?
 - c. Did you find the setting fascinating?
2. Characters (one paragraph)
 - a. Can you relate to the characters?
 - b. Are the relationships between the characters believable?
 - c. Do you have strong feelings about the characters?
3. Plot (one paragraph)
 - a. Are you hooked from beginning to end?
 - b. Is the plot entertaining (especially the climax) and easy to follow?
 - c. How did the author accomplish the previous two questions?
4. Your recommendations (one paragraph)
 - a. Is this a book worth buying?
 - b. Would you recommend it to kids your age?
 - c. Have you been changed by reading this book?
 - d. Did the author make you think about other issues related to the book?
