### **CURRICULUM**

Herndon High School's comprehensive curriculum includes: health and physical education, honor courses at all grade levels in four disciplines, and a special education center. In addition, preparation in Fairfax County's Vocational/Technical Center provides skill courses for post-graduate employment.

Advanced Placement courses carry an additional .5 quality points and are offered as follows: World History II, U.S. History, U.S. Government, U.S. and Comparative Government, Human Geography, Psychology, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, German, Latin, Spanish, French, Calculus AB and BC, Statistics, Computer Science, Music Theory, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Art 2-D and 3-D Design, and Studio Art.
