

## **Summer Governor's School Interest Meeting – October 8, 2:20**

10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students who would like to learn more about the summer Residential Governor's School programs in the academics and visual and performing arts should attend this info session in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade Health classroom, 180. Students who attended last summer's session will be in attendance to enthusiastically share some of their experiences.

NOTE: Students interested in the *Foreign Language* Governor's School should inquire with their foreign language teachers.

The application process, timeline, and qualifications will be discussed in the meeting and students will be given a handout with additional details. These programs are *highly* competitive. For the academic programs, accepted students *usually* have extremely high GPAs, have taken a very rigorous course load and, have outstanding standardized test scores. For the fine and performing arts, students have *usually* excelled in their arts classes here, undertaken additional instruction outside school, and may also have won awards or recognitions for their work/performance.
