Purpose of Stinger Time

- Stinger Time was developed to provide an opportunity for students to get additional help.
- Students may go to other teachers or another location to work on assignments or get help, if their Stinger teacher agrees.

What's NOT changing...

- Students may still request an ORANGE pass from a teacher to visit him/her during a Stinger period.
- Students may still request a YELLOW pass from their Stinger teacher to go to the Library. Each teacher can send 2 students at a time to the Library.
- The TEACHER gets to decide what activity will take place during Stinger and whether or not a student may leave.
- If students go to another teacher or Library during Stinger Time and finish their work early, they may return to their original Stinger class.
- No movement will occur during seminar days.

Stinger Changes

- Students with an A or B in a class may ask for the teacher's permission to go to the lecture hall or the cafeteria.
- Students with a C, D, or F in a class will stay with their teacher for extra help.
- These changes will begin on November 4th (beginning of the 2nd quarter).

Where to: Lecture Hall or Cafeteria?

- The Lecture Hall will serve as a QUIET location for students to read, study, or work on assignments.
- The Cafeteria will be a place for students to mingle with their friends.
- Lecture Hall passes will be GREEN.
Cafeteria passes will be BLUE.

Expectations

- Once the teacher agrees that a student may leave, he or she must receive a pass from that teacher and sign out from the teacher's room.
- Students will have until 9:05 to get to their designated room. Students found in the hall or unapproved areas after 9:05 will receive a disciplinary consequence.
- Once students arrive to the lecture hall or cafeteria, they will turn in their pass and will NOT be allowed to leave until the end of Stinger.
