- Dr. Dale presented new budget - \$45.6 million in cuts
- Options are: increase student (mainly sports activity fees, increase class size (to reduce the number of teachers), revamp summer school (completely scrap it and start all over again), eliminate excess Instructional Assistants (through program revamping), expand on-line schools and charge for test fees for IB/AP/PSAT.
- No new programs are proposed. Public hearings on the budget will be held February 6. The budget will be adopted by the School Board on February 14 and will be presented to the Board of Supervisors April 1. The new budget will take effect July 1.
