We would like to announce our 2011 summer reading program for rising second graders at Hunt Valley Elementary. In an effort to encourage reading and build a love for good literature, we are hopeful that you will help your child with his/her project. This year's theme centers around an amusement park and our slogan is **“Have a THRILL!, Be a Hunt Valley Summer Reader”**. Rising second grade students must read twenty books over the summer. In addition, the student's name will be displayed near the school entrance and he/she will be recognized on the Hunt Valley Daily News Program. For every 5 additional books read, each student will receive a bonus prize.

Completed forms should be returned to the Hunt Valley Library no later than Friday, September 16th, 2011.
