1. **FCA** (Fellowship of Christian Athletes) is a student-led club that participates in community service projects and offers discussions that center on values that Christians hold.
2. **TSA** (Technology Student Association) is an academic enrichment club that allows students to take part in regional/state/national competitions by submitting projects they create within the club. Last year our Ms. Domer brought four students to nationals and won 2nd place!
3. **Guy's Club** is a place for "dudes" to hang out and do community service, learn cool guy things like how to tie a tie and have guy-centered discussions.
