

Second Quarter Project on American Indians

We have been studying three major American Indian regions: Eastern Woodlands, Plains and Southwest. In these regions we have focused on the Powhatan (Woodlands), Sioux (Plains) and Hopi (Southwest). Listed below are several suggestions for your second quarter project. Please feel free to come up with your own ideas and be as creative as you can.

1. Create a diorama or model showing the housing of a particular American Indian tribe. Write about what you have created.
2. Make an American Indian game and write the rules for it. Be ready to demonstrate how to play the game in class.
3. Learn an American Indian song. Write the words on a chart and teach it to the class.
4. Be a storyteller and share an American Indian folktale.
5. Make an American Indian artifact. Write about it and explain it to the class.
6. Draw a map of the United States showing where the different tribes were located.
7. Make and model some traditional American Indian clothing.
8. Pretend you are an American Indian. Write about one of your customs or traditions.
