If so, write it's name on the paper.</p>
<p>How would the world be different if there were no maps? Would it be a better or worse place? What could people use to find their way? Explain your thoughts in your journal.</p>	<p>Virginia's state flower is the Dogwood. Do you feel this is the best choice? Why or why not?
