I am east.

This is a very small rise in land. It might make you huff and puff when you walk up one but it is not a mountain. It rhymes with Bill.

I am a hill.

This is something people travel on. It can be paved with asphalt, made of gravel or even dirt. You should walk on the sidewalk because cars travel on this.
