**All cover-art entries must meet the following criteria. Please read these directions carefully! Entries that do not follow them will be disqualified.**

-  Artwork should be drawn on **8½ X 11 plain white paper**. Do not use lined paper unless it is part of your design. All designs should be **vertical** (long sides of the paper on the right and left, like this sheet). **No horizontal entries will be accepted.**
-  Designs should be completed using markers, crayons, or colored pencils. **Color should be bold and heavy**, so that everything will show up well when printed.
-  **Please maintain a half-inch margin around your design**, so that nothing is lost during the final printing and trimming process, **UNLESS** you choose to use a background color or pattern that can run all the way to the edge.
-  Please **sign your artwork**. **Please attach this form to the back of your artwork.**

**Parents please note:** This artwork should be done by your child alone. Any entries that are obviously drawn by parents or older siblings will be disqualified.

***All entries must be turned in to the office by Friday, November 4.***  
***Late entries will not be accepted!***
