## Academic Support

Students needing additional assistance outside of the classroom can access help from:

### Teachers

1. After School – Monday is the late bus day (bus departs app. 3:45), thus all teachers are available after school on this day. Additionally most teachers are available other days of the week. Students should see their teacher to find out the best day to meet with them personally.

2. Saxon Time – As Langley’s designated academic support time teachers are available in their classroom on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays to assist students. Any student who has a “D” or “F” in a class must go to that class during Saxon Time on the assigned day (schedule below).

- Monday                      World Languages, Electives
- Tuesday                     Science
- Thursday                    Humanities
- Friday                        Math

NOTE: If students are having difficulties in a class talking with their teacher is always the best place to start to improve.

### Peer Tutoring

All departments offer peer tutoring through their Honor Societies (schedule below). Many students can also schedule peer tutoring on Wednesday before school begins.

Subject	Directions
Science	See Mrs. Landis (Rm. 131) Give her your name, e-mail, subject in which you need help, and days of the week you would like it.
Math	Get a tutor request form from your teacher and a math tutor will be assigned to you.
English	Go to the Saxon Writing Center (Rm. 293 or Rm. 295) and sign up for a tutor during all lunches everyday.
History	See Ms. Schettini (Rm. 210) and a history tutor will be assigned to you.
French	Get a tutor request form from your teacher and a tutor will be assigned to you.
German	Request a tutor from Herr Rademacher (Quad #1).
Japanese	Request a tutor from Sensei Scronce (Rm. 246)
Latin	Request a tutor from Dr. Tannenbaum (Rm. 238).
Spanish	Two tutors are available during Saxon Time for Spanish I (Rm. 255), Spanish II (Rm. 253), and Spanish III (Rm. 257).
