



Dear Langley Parents and Students:

This is an invitation to attend the Advanced Placement Workshop for Students on Thursday, August 21st at Langley High School. The workshop is an opportunity for rising sophomore, junior and senior students to familiarize themselves with the expectations, curriculum, and requirements of the AP courses that they are enrolled in for the upcoming school year. Please note that the workshop covers courses in the Humanities, Mathematics, and Science departments. Any courses that are not listed will not be previewed at the workshop.

The workshop will run from 8:00 am to 3:15 pm. First-time AP students are invited to participate in the morning workshop, that will include three learning skills sessions that focus on critical reading skills, analytical writing skills, and test-taking strategies. Following a complimentary lunch for all-day attendees, both new and experienced AP students can participate in course-specific sessions offered in the afternoon. Students may select up to four presentations to attend. The presentations will be conducted by the Langley High School faculty and will focus on course content and activities, as well as the required summer assignments. All AP teachers hold certification to teach their respective AP Courses.

Students who are enrolled in an Advanced Placement course for next year are strongly encouraged to attend, regardless of their previous AP experience. The fall sports coaching staff is fully supportive of the workshop. If you have questions regarding a conflict with a particular sport or activity, please contact the coach or sponsor directly.

Each workshop participant should complete the enclosed enrollment form along with a check made out to Langley High School. The fee for first-time AP students, who will be attending both the morning and afternoon sessions, is \$50. The fee for experienced AP students, who will be attending the afternoon session only, is \$25.
