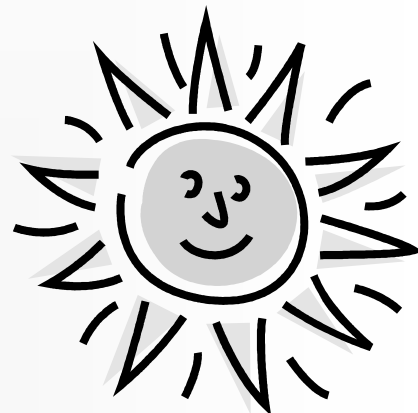

## WHY CAMP?

Band Camp provides an extended and focused opportunity for students to quickly learn or progress on their instruments. In three weeks, they will have more instructional time than in an entire year of elementary school lessons! Rising middle school students will find themselves better prepared for seating auditions at their home school.

The students will be divided into two bands according to their experience and ability:

**Red Band**—*For students new to their instrument or with minimal experience.* We will develop the essentials for each instrument, placing heavy emphasis on tone production and music reading.

**Blue Band**— *For students with two or more years experience on their instrument.* In this band, we will continue to build a good foundation by developing solid tone, technical skills and musicality through more advanced music.

## A DAY AT CAMP

The day will be structured like this:

- 8:30 Full Band Rehearsal
- 9:30 Master class (woodwinds, brass, and percussion divide)
- 10:00 Break (concessions will be sold or students may enjoy a snack brought from home)
- 10:15 Sectionals
- 11:00 Full Band Rehearsal
