

**Here's how to make
a Poser person's face
look HAPPY!**



1. Go to the face shaping tool box.
2. Go to the mouth tab.
3. The subsections will appear. One of the subsections is the mouth.
4. Click on the mouth. Then, click the (+) button.
5. Click the Happy/Sad wheel and drag the mouse to the left.

REMEMBER

The only way you can make the face you want is if you experiment with the subsections.

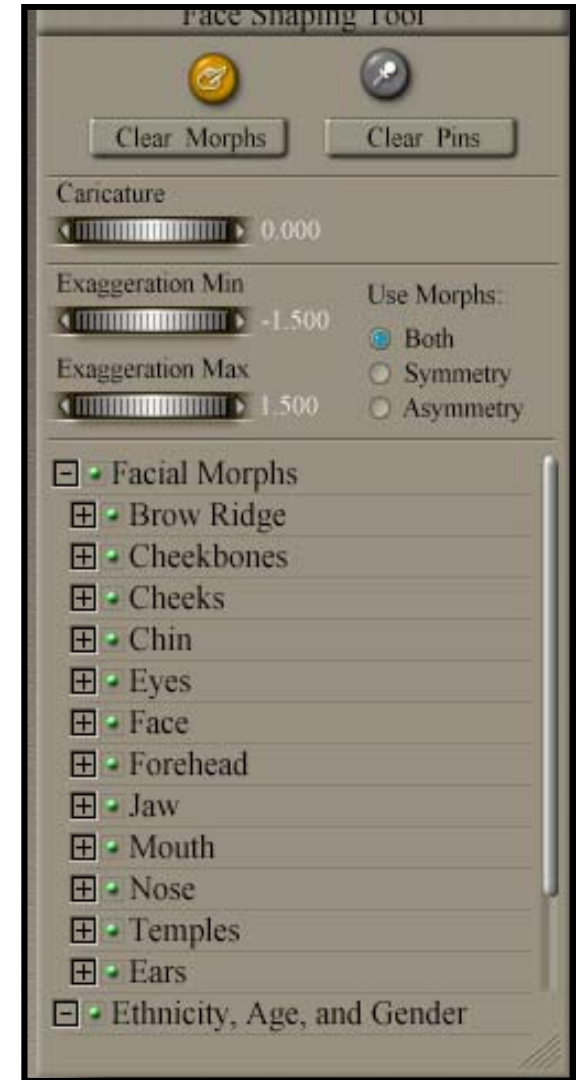
POSER allows you to create a variety of facial expressions on your 3D characters, using the Face Shaping Tool. In this Tutorial, we will explain how to find and use this awesome tool.

1. Open Poser 6.
2. Click on the "Face" tab at the top of the screen.
3. On the bottom right of the screen, you will see the "Face Shaping Tool" box. This is where you will make most of the changes to the face.

THE FACE SHAPING TOOL

In the "Face Shaping Tool" box, there are tabs (e.g. cheekbones). When you click the (+) button, it opens to subsections (ex. High/Low). These make the actual changes to the faces.

Some of the subsections include brow ridge, nose, and mouth. Click on the wheel, move it from side to side, and see how the look of the face changes.
