

## PEER TEACHING

Anchoring is not the only thing that GMJM anchors do... they also teach others— Grade 7 & 8 M2P Semester students —how to anchor on GMJM. Here are some tips on peer teaching.

- Be clear when explaining to new anchors what they have to say and do for the show.
- Explain the show content order. Make decisions about who will saying what.
- Encourage the anchors before and after the show. Some of them are very nervous, and encouragement always helps!!!!

**Try, try, and try again!!**

**Don't worry at first if these skills don't come right away. They come only after hard work and practice. Besides, anchoring improves multi-tasking and communication skills!!**

## Things to do before the show

- Get the paper for the “Wisdom of the day” from the binder that reads “program copy”, which is in the cupboard located in the studio.
- Always read over the script before the show. Ask a responsible adult any words that are unfamiliar to you.
- Practice reading the script at least once aloud, so that you do not feel nervous “on camera”.
- Tell the camera person what is going to happen during the show, when to zoom in and out. This will prevent any silly mistakes during the show.
- Make sure the microphones are on.

## When ‘on camera’...

- Start talking only when the director points at you. The director gets the signal from other crew members, so it is important that you follow this rule.
- Always remember to smile, especially when you make mistakes! A smile always adds to your show!
- Occasionally look up at the camera. It looks better.

This takes effort, but with practice, you will get there!



## After the show...

GMJM anchors are the ones who clean up. Here are some of the tasks that need to be completed:

- Make sure the microphones are turned off.
- The microphones have to be rolled up, with the mic facing up. Place in the brown box in order.
- Place the wisdom in the same place in the binder from where you took it in the beginning.
- The stopwatch, the extra passes, and the attendance clip board goes in the box that is placed in the cupboard.
- The best of all is that the anchors get special passes, the ones that have no time written on it!! (you cannot put more than 8:05 though because the show is over at 8:00!!)
