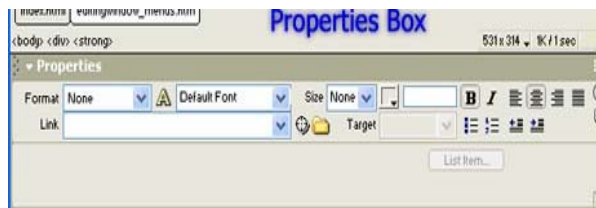


# The Design Mode

Features include the changing of font, the changing of the color of text and/or background, the importing of images, and the importing of tables.

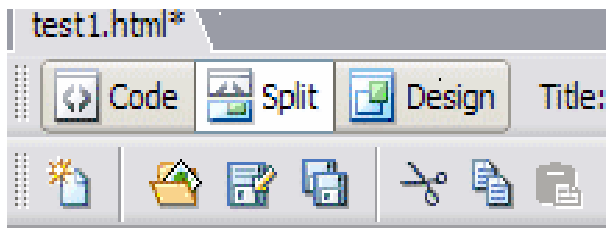

# THE THREE MODES

There are three setup modes for DreamWeaver MX. They are code, split, and design. The three modes allow website visitors to choose how they want to view your webpage.

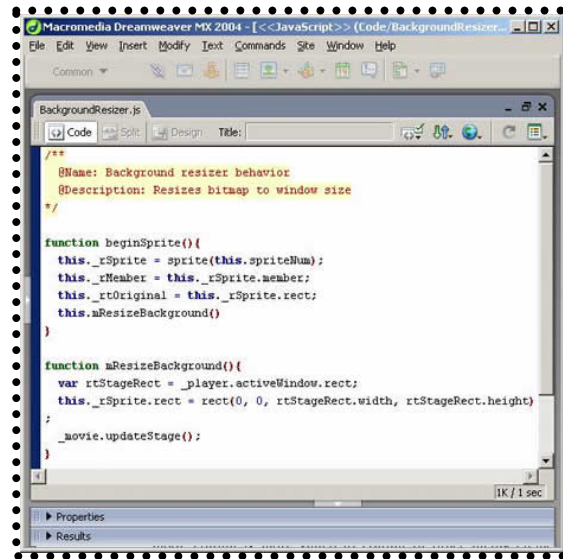
When the visitor first opens the program and chooses the HTML tab, the first thing they see are the three tabs at the top that show the modes.

## The Code Mode

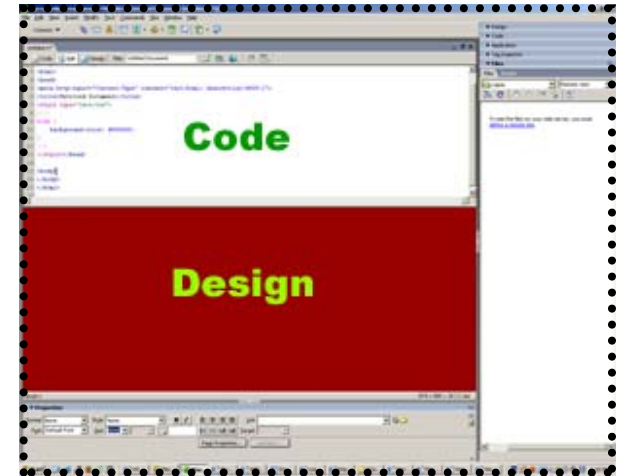
Dreamweaver has a viewing option known as the code mode. In this mode, everything displayed is written by you in HTML, the basic language of the internet. One must be skilled in HTML to be able to use this mode, in order to ensure that their page appears correctly.

## The Split Mode

Another viewing option in Dreamweaver is the split mode. This mode allows you to see what has been written (e.g. in English), and how its translated into HTML code. This is the least complex of the three modes because you can learn what the codes will be at the same time as you are writing English.
