

Downloading Google Earth

1. Go to earth.google.com .
2. In the upper right hand corner of your screen, click on **Get Google Earth**.
3. Click on download in the upper right hand corner of the screen and choose your computer type.
4. Then you save and you can start Google Earth from there, or find it under Programs on your Start menu.

Tips For Use

You can look at any country:

- Find the white rectangular box in the upper left hand corner of the screen.
- Enter a postal code, street address or the name of a landmark.
