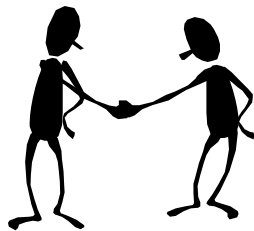

Mac

A Mac is an Apple computer with many user interfaces and media tools.

A Mac

- has a personal computing platform
- is mainly targeted for/at home, education, and creative professional markets
- currently installed with the latest version 10.4.9 Mac OS X “Leopard”



How to decide?

A PC

- runs only on Microsoft Windows
- is mainly used for word processing, internet browsing, E-mailing, and other digital, messaging and forms of communication.
