

Multiple Pips

How about changing the colors?

To change the background of a tile, use the arrow keys to select the tiles of your choice. You will be able to see the colors change at the top right corner of the TV screen (the mixer TV monitor). Continue to click background color to reach your desired color choice.



This is an example of a multiple pips with the 16 tile configuration using set 1 and HP.

Glossary

1. Joystick: the lever used to move single pips (tile) around the screen.
2. Mixer: a.k.a. MXPro, device that controls options, such as; transitions, pips, and effects.
3. Configuration Table: a.k.a. number key; allows you to choose different number configurations for multiple pips.
4. Pips: a.k.a. picture in picture; allows you to put more than one picture on the same screen.
5. Multiple Pips: allows you to have more than one tile on the screen using the configuration table.
6. Effects: different options (e.g. BG color, border color, and border style) that jazz up your tiles for pips.

Messin' With the TV Studio Mixer

The mixer is one of the pieces of equipment in the TV studio. There are many features on the mixer, one of which is pips.

Single Pips

Pips stands for picture in picture. Pips allows you to place a tile of one set into another. (In the picture below, Set 1 with the frog is the pips tile while Set 2 is the main set. *Ari is the main set.)

Steps:

1. To operate single pips you need at least two inputs, preferably set 1 and 2.
2. First, press set 2 and push play. You should now see set 2 on the main monitor.
3. Press set 1 so that it is blinking.
4. Press the pips button on the far left of the mixer and the object in set 1 should appear in a small box on the monitor on the left of the main monitor.

5. With the joystick, maneuvers pips to the desired position and press play.



*Ari is the main set and the frog is pips

To remove pips, simply press pips again.

Pips Design Elements

Now that you've learned how to operate pips, here's how to use all the cool borders and shapes that go with it.

- Once you have positioned your pips, you can design the pips border.
- There are many options:
 - *BG (background)
 - *Border color
 - *Border style
 - *Shapes
- To operate border option, simply press on either of these buttons until you have reached the desired option.
- Another way to change the shape is by pressing on the configuration table located in the middle of the mixer.

Configuration Table

Multiple Pips

Multiple pips is used to show more than one scene at once.



This is what a 16 tile multiple pips would look like.

Steps:

- To activate multiple pips, press pips and shift at the same time.
- To change the number of tiles, use the configuration table and click on the number that corresponds to the configuration of your choice.
