

Things to Keep in Mind

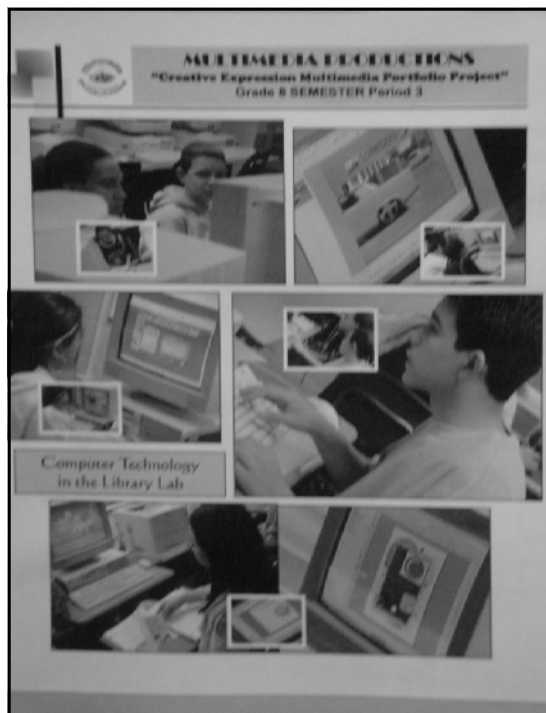
* Feel the freedom to experiment with your pictures.

For example, put a picture as an insert inside another picture.

* Sizing pictures is fun.

Carefully select which pictures you want to be bigger, and which ones smaller.

Our advice—select the more dramatic ones with the strongest message and image(s), and size them bigger.



Look at how the smaller pictures are inserted in each of the above pictures.

* Watch where you place pictures in relation to nearby pictures. Look at the edges. Sometimes they look good lined up exactly with other pictures, and other times, you might want to offset them.

* Sometimes lots of small pictures, creatively aligned, can serve your visual purpose. For example, you might want to show a progression of activity between your subjects, so you include a series of small pictures.

In another example, you might simply want to show that a lot of activity is going on, so a lot of pictures serves this purpose.



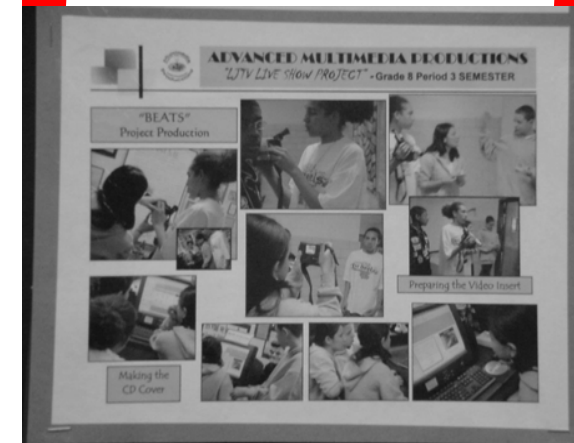

Create Awesome Photo Displays



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What are the purposes of photo displays?

- ☼ Photo displays show what we are learning in class.
- ☼ Photo displays show our involvement in the material we are learning.
- ☼ Photo displays express our ideas.
- ☼ Photo displays communicate without words.

What do you need in order to create a photo display?

- ◆ A digital still camera that stores pictures on a disk is a fast and easy way to capture your pictures.
- ◆ The pictures you want to include in the display. Take some extras just in case.
- ◆ Permission to be on a computer with Microsoft Publisher. We prefer Publisher because this program has formats which let you resize your photos.
- ◆ Make sure you have a good subject to photograph, a creative eye and remember, *have fun!*

The Sony Mavica camera is a terrific little digital camera!



Steps

- 1) Take pictures with a digital camera and save on a blank disk.
- 2) Insert disk into the computer.
- 3) Open Microsoft Publisher and click on a format; such as, SIGNS.
- 4) Delete everything on the page that you don't want.
- 5) Insert the pictures you want by going to the tool bar at the top of the screen and selecting -
Insert, Picture, from File, Desktop, and then, 3-1/2 floppy.
- 6) Select a click Insert.
- 7) REMEMBER, when you insert a picture, make sure that any previous pictures on your page are not highlighted. A new insert will replace the highlighted picture.
- 8) If you want to rotate a picture or text, go to the tool bar and click on Arrange, Rotate or Flip, and choose your own flipping style.
- 9) To put a border around a picture, go to the tool bar and click on Format, go down to Line/Border style, and click the thickness and color (More Styles...) of your border.
- 10) Repeat step 7-10 until your display is completely done.
