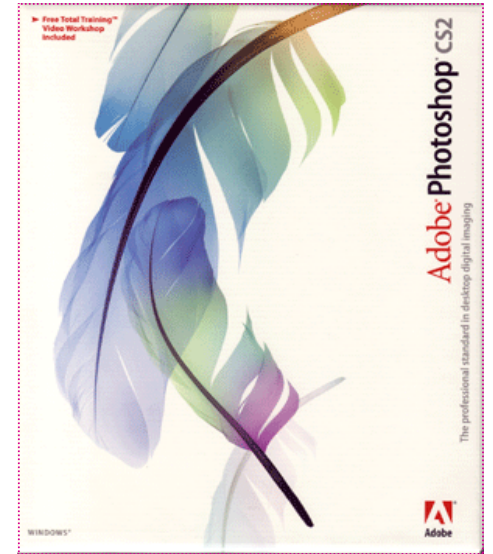

In this tutorial, we will explain some of the Photoshop’s basic tools, and provide examples.

Some Cool Tools To Use

Color Balance —adds more colors to the whole image.

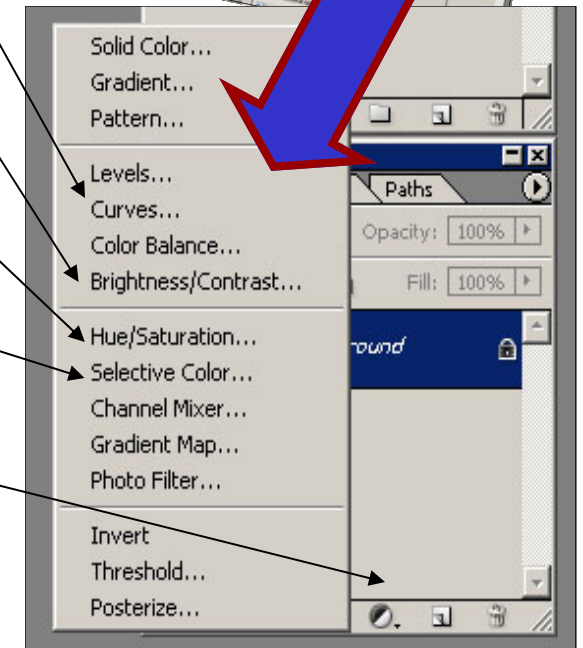
Brightness/Contrast—brightens your picture and raises or lowers the color contrast of the photo.

Hues/Saturations—soaks and changes the colors in the picture.

Selective Color—changes only one color part of the photo.

All of these tools are located in the half-black and half-white button at the bottom right corner.

When you click on each tool, you will see effects that range from –100 to 100. Move the bar from the highest point to the lowest point, in order to adjust the definition of each
