

## Useful Tips

- Use a resolution of 640 by 480 for the screen
- Large bold text is easier to read.

Thin Text  
**Bold Text**

- Use bold lines instead of fine details

Bold Line



Fine Details



- Use only 85% of the center screen to avoid cut offs around the edges.
- Choose colors carefully.
  - Don't use yellow text on a white screen.
  - The yellow and white are very similar colors and hard to read.
- Adjust the brightness to avoid glares of the screen
- Use solid color text for clarity

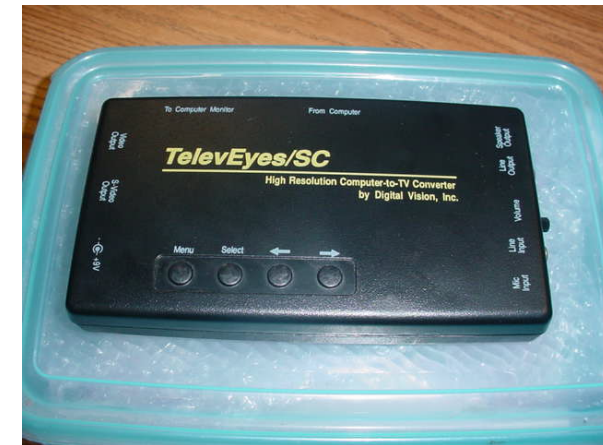

## Uses

- Use a presentation from a laptop screen to a large meeting room data projector.
- Create video from computer-edited feature.
- Show images from a computer to a large TV.



## Requirements

### PC

- Works with all IBM PC's
- Can work with VCRs to record images
- Can work with TV, computer monitors, or data projector monitors to display images

### MAC

- Will work on all Macintosh display cards
- Can work with TV, computer monitors, or data projector monitors to display images

## Set up

### Steps:

1. Plug in the A/C power adaptor. Make sure the red light is on.



2. Turn on all equipments to be used.



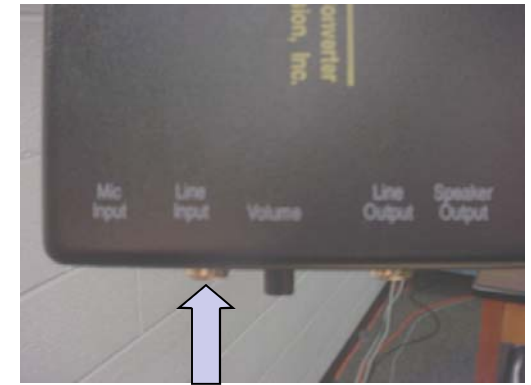
*For both PC's and Macs, complete steps 3 and 4 in a gentle, slow motion.*

3. Connect the short cable to the "Computer's Monitor." The other end of the cable should be connected to the computer's display card.
4. Connect the long cable to the "From Computer" on the scanner.



## Set up (Cont.)

5. On the side of the scanner, press the button labeled "Input."



## Audio Uses

The Scanner has audio amplifier and volume control.

### Qualities:

- Amplify voices
- Add narrations
- Control volume

The Scanner is known for it's amazing sound. The volume control allows control of the sound levels during a presentation. It consists of a microphone input plug in, and can control the volume on videos, too.
