

Senior Parking Information for 2008 - 2009

Rising seniors who wish to park on school grounds must purchase a parking permit for **\$150.00 and submit the following forms** (signed by **both** student and parent/legal guardian) in September (the exact dates and times will be announced during the first week of school.)

Parking assignments will be made when the completed applications with payment are accepted by security. Until parking assignments are made, student parking will be open to all students except in spaces marked with a "T". The "T" marked spaces are for staff, and students parking in those spaces could be ticketed or towed, plus you could lose your opportunity to get a parking permit.

The following information contains some of the basic parking regulations that students most often have to deal with. This is not a complete list. Please see the parking application packet for the complete list of parking rules and regulations. If there are any questions, please contact the security office at **703-319-2341**. The security office is closed during the summer months, spring break, and winter break.

Seniors are given *first priority* for student parking—before Juniors are considered. The remaining parking spaces will be sold to Juniors based on the Student Participation Form. The Madison HS administrative staff reserves the right to deny parking to any student at any time.

Student vehicles parked on school property **must display** a current Madison HS parking permit in clear view from the rear view mirror at all times while on school property. ***Failure to display permit will result in a \$10.00 ticket.*** Students can park *only* in their assigned parking space. ***If a student has a parking problem, they should notify security immediately.*** Vehicles found in violation will be ticketed and could be booted or towed.

Once students arrive at school they must promptly enter the building and cannot return to their vehicles until their school day is complete without a pass from security or their administrators. Students are expected to obey all traffic laws and to drive in a safe and courteous manner at all times when on or near school property. ***Students who drive in violation of the law or in an unsafe manner may lose their parking privileges.*** There are ***no refunds*** on parking fees.

The replacement fee for a lost/stolen/damaged parking permit is \$10.00. ***Students who leave school grounds in violation of school rules, DRIVING OR NOT, WILL LOSE THEIR PARKING PERMIT FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SCHOOL YEAR!!! YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND AND IF AN UNDERCLASSMAN, YOU WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR A PARKING PERMIT THE FOLLOWING YEAR!!!***
